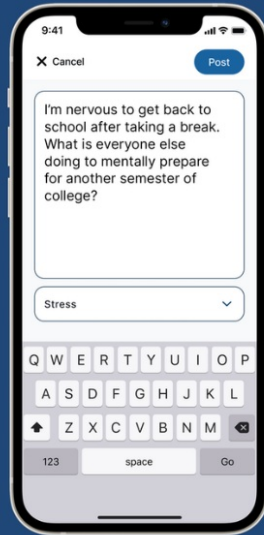
Attention All New and Returning Students: Carroll Cares About Your Health and Success!
