Attention Students Applying to the Associate Degree Clinical Nursing Program

Applications are now being accepted for the Fall 2025 clinical RN program and the Summer 2025 Transitions to clinical RN program (LPN to RN, Paramedic to RN, Military Medic to RN).

All applicants must take the NLN NEX preadmission examination and receive a score of 138 on the composite section by February 15, 2025 to be considered for acceptance. You may retest every 30 days.

Applications will be accepted from November 15, 2024 through February 15, 2025 by 4:00 p.m.




Wellbeing Wednesday: Let's Talk About Mental Health!


So You Think You Can Drive?


