- First opportunity to register for summer and fall 2025



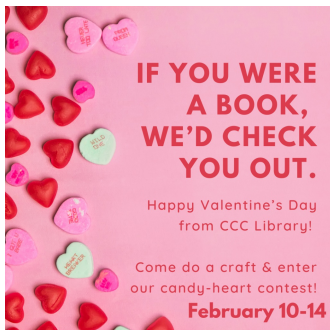
